I. <u>Grants and Marketing Committee</u>

1. Illinois Transportation Enhancement Program Grant

Director Harms explained the details of this Grant and informed the Board that the district will not be applying for this Grant.

2. Tourism Attraction Grant

Executive Director Harms asked the Board for approval for staff to apply for the Tourism Attractions part of the Tourism Attractions & Festivals Grant to support the Conservatory Dome Renovation project for Washington Park Botanical Garden. The total anticipated cost of this project would be \$750,000. The grant funds will be used for a complete replacement of the existing Conservatory Dome structure, replace leaking windows in the three entryway connections into the dome and a HVAC cooling system replacement to the three existing cooling towers that frequently break down.

3. OSLAD Grant

Executive Director Harms informed the Board that Staff would like to apply for the FY23 OSLAD Grant and presented the Board with a list of proposed projects. Staff strongly recommends Option 1: Veterans Memorial Pool removal and replacing with Splash Pad.
